Summary of Unity Board Meeting
September 11, 2018

- A comparison of our financial status to 2017 reveals:
 - ◇ 2017 offerings for August \$1,700 below projected income
 - ◇ 2018 offerings for August \$1,200 below projected income
 - ◇ 2017 ending balance was negative \$18,728 (mostly due to our ceiling repair bill of \$16,000)
 - ◇ 2018 ending balance is \$9,727. We replaced parts for the a/c unit, repaired the sanitizer in the kitchen and contracted for maintenance on the fire exits.
- We have paid our Provincial Share through August with designated funds. There is still \$13,477 to be used for future months.
- We will not have to vote for a representative to our Regional Council of Churches (RCC). The representatives are appointed by the Church Boards.
- Personnel Policies for full-time employees have been published in a handbook which will be distributed to all employees.
- The Board has asked the Building and Grounds Committee to install windows in the doors leading into the Fellowship Hall.
- The September and October Community Concerns project is to collect funds to purchase supplies to make 100 birthing kits for women in third-world countries. Each kit will cost \$11.00 and will be used to save one mother and her offspring. Also, in October, Will Smith is coordinating our annual CROP walk. A display table in the narthex has additional information.
- Our Church Council will be held on September 30th. There are four proposed amendment changes to our Articles of Incorporation. Please read over them carefully. Questions may be addressed to any board member or to the Pastor.
