The Kitchen Committee

Points to Remember:

- We do not have a cleaning crew for our kitchen. If you use the kitchen, you must clean it, put away all utensils in their proper place (bins/cabinets are labeled) sweep the floor and, if needed, mop. Also, if you use towels, you need to wash them and return them to the church.
- Do not bring towels from home. Only white towels are needed as they must be bleached when washed.
- Do not bring items that you think we need. If you have an idea of something needed, you must clear it with the Kitchen Committee before bringing or buying it.
- If you have a function in the kitchen, please take everything back home with you (all pans, utensils, food, etc.).
- Do not leave food in the refrigerator unless it is for a scheduled event at church. If you leave it in the refrigerator, it must be labeled with date and name. If it gets old and spoils, someone else must spend their time cleaning it up.
- Our freezers are for use by our church members for functions of the church. Personal frozen food is not to be stored in our freezers.
