Report from the Unity Board Retreat

The newly elected Church Board met for a 3 ½ hour retreat on Saturday, January 11th. We had 100% attendance and the agenda was full. The following items were addressed and finalized:

Our congregation has received two large monetary gifts: one from Hilda Vestal to be used in future plans for the graveyard, and the other gift from the Erma and Lois Watkins Estate. The Board will be working with both families in determining how these gifts will be used by our congregation to further the mission of Christ here at Unity.

An "ongoing" Church-wide "Clean-up & Re-organize" effort is being initiated by the Building and Grounds Committee in response to the new Fire Inspector's recommendations. The Committee is also moving forward ASAP on replacing the two HVAC units for the Sanctuary.

We are continuing our search for Church Staffing possibilities in the areas of Music, Children's Programming and Communications.

2020 marks the 40th Anniversary of Unity which was chartered on November 16, 1980. We will be looking at ways throughout the year to celebrate this congregation's four decades of service to Christ's Holy Church in Lewisville, North Carolina.
